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The Uniform Guidance (UG) updates from the Federal Office of Management and Budget set the Micro-purchase procurement method to \$10,000 and increased the Small Purchase Procedures threshold to \$250,000, effective June 20, 2018. Under UG, non-Federal entities must comply with the more restrictive of Federal, state, and entity-level requirements. The following table outlines the procurement methods to be used for the acquisition of goods and services when using Federal funds.

Note: Federal and state acquisition thresholds are adjusted periodically.
